




A4. What size Post are you?






A7. What Division are you from?



^{* - 16%} of the Posts do not know what Division they are aligned against.


A8. Does your Post have their own brick and mortar building? 0 / 142 correct responses



^{* - 55%} of the Posts have their own building to conduct American Legion business.


A9. How many National Patriotic Events did your Post support?


A10. How many Post Legislative Committee Members were appointed? 0 / 142 correct responses





A11. How many Americanism Programs did your Post support last year?






1-1. Does your Post have a VSO?






1-2. Is your Post attending meetings of local elected officials or utilizing other means to share information with community and the Legion family?









1-3. Does your Post VSO programs involve improvement to access to care (healthcare needs)? 0 / 142 correct responses






1-4. Is your Post actively involved in educating members and the community of the benefits of the PACT Act?









2-1. Do you have a current Disaster Preparedness Plan established? (more current than 2020) 0 / 142 correct responses






2-3. Has a Border Security POC/Chairman been appointed?





2-4. Did you partner with area AD, USAR, NGB members or families? Place N/A if none exist within 20 miles of Post.




2-5. Has your Post appointed any legislative committee members? 0 / 142 correct responses


2-6. Do you have any programs supporting Emergency Responders besides the annual awards program?


2-7. Did you appoint a community relations lead (Chairman, Director, etc.)? 0 / 142 correct responses



* - Just having one person appointed as Chairman and attending meetings with city will lead to higher intake of new members.


3-1. Do you have a newsletter?

* - Wow, I assumed this would be 100%. E-newsletter is cost effective and helps with retention, membership numbers, and participation/support of activities. Key to any Post's success.


3-2. Have you made communication improvements in the past year?








3-3. Do you have or support a Youth Cadet Law Enforcement Program? 0 / 142 correct responses






3-4. How often are Buddy Checks performed at the Post level per year?

3-5. Did your Post increase, stay the same, or decrease involvement of Americanism programs last year?








4-1. Did your Post or ALR Chapter advertise accomplishments and/or the intent of supporting Children and Youth programs?






4-2. Does the Post participate in at least one info booth per year?


4-3. Have you hosted a police child safety event with drug discussions and or fingerprinting? 0 / 142 correct responses





* - I would have expected more but age demographics is probably why numbers are low...but grandchildren are also part of our future and safety of all children is a core responsibility of our Posts.




4-5. Did your ALR chapter or Post conduct activities that earn funds for CWF? 0 / 142 correct responses




* - The Children and Youth Foundation is a relatively new State program that ALR is supporting and Posts should help by incorporating their fundraiseing efforts into that of the ALR.

5-1. Does the Post have Bylaws?





5-2. Did you conduct or offer Post-level training on the American Legion College? 0 / 142 correct responses




* - Due to the average sample size of the Posts, I would expect these numbers to be low but Districts and Divisions should work with their talent to provide this training.



5-2. Did you participate in District or Division level training?



* - Good start but this would be the expected outcome of this question if the majority of the surveys came back from leadership versus general membership. Need to get general membership educated and involved.




5-3. Have you improved communication platforms or data management in the past year? 0 / 142 correct responses



* - Assume this will get better as the % of members who know how to use automation increases. As the older (non-computerized) generation gradually attrits, we expect these results to get better.




5-4. Do you possess or are you working on a Post-level Mission and Vision statement? 0 / 142 correct responses
